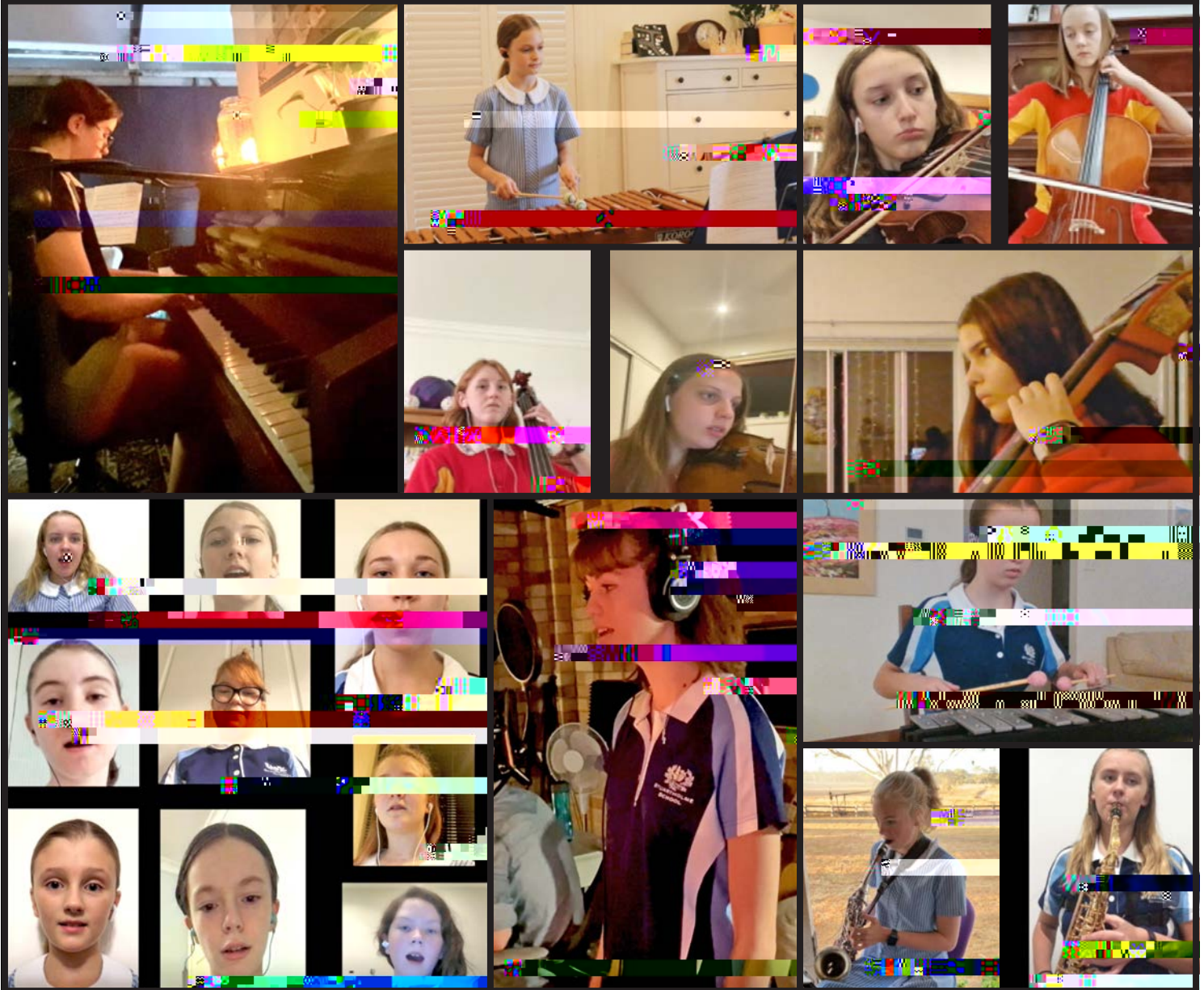

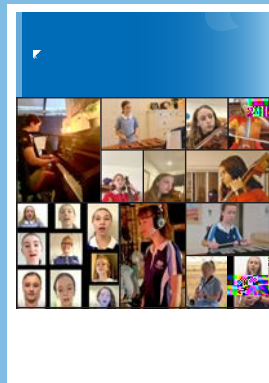

Tennis courts were an early addition to the Stuartholme property as the first reference to them that is still on record is in January 1923, where an entry in the Economat Journal (a diary of the month's business transactions) states: "The dry weather prevented us from finishing the tennis courts that were only partly fenced and wired." A few months later in July we read: "The work on the tennis courts interrupted on account of the dry weather
